

ABSTRACT

This paper aims to get an explanation of the government's role in controlling and controlling the GRIB and FKPPi mass organizations in Indramayu District. In this study, the authors use the theory of (1) Role, which relates to a person's position or status in exercising his rights and obligations, (2) The function of state government, which relates to ensuring state security and maintaining public order, (3) State and community relations, relating to guarantees for human rights where freedom of expression, (4) Policy, is an effort to solve social problems for the benefit of society on the principles of justice and public welfare, (5) Community organizations, which are related to organizations in the purpose, function, and formation of community groups. This research is a descriptive qualitative research. This research is a descriptive qualitative research using a case study approach. The sampling technique used in this research is purposive sampling technique. Data collection techniques using interviews and documentation studies. Data validity uses source triangulation. Data analysis techniques using data reduction, data presentation and conclusions.

The results of the study found that the optimization of the functions of CSOs in Indramayu Regency is still not optimal as measured by the theory of the role and function of government. Regarding the role of the government in dealing with problems in Kamtibmas and politics in the GRIB and FKPPi Ormas in Indramayu, it is considered that there is still a low level of human resources among members of the GRIB Ormas in the beating phenomenon at the Al-Zaytun Islamic Boarding School, because in solving problems they still use hand-to-hand (violence) and participated in the support of one of the candidate pairs in the Indramayu Pilkada. The Regional Government, in this case the Indramayu National Unity and Political Agency, has provided guidance in the form of outreach and supervision of CBOs. However, bearing in mind that there are still members of Ormas who do not pay attention to Kamtibmas, it is hoped that in this training the knowledge of conflict resolution against members of the Ormas is expected to be increased, which is expected to make the quality of human resources easier to understand the purpose of socialization and prevent conflicts between fellow Ormass.
