Active learning of students in participating in learning activities is a basic element in the success of a learning process. Preparation of students so that they have technical skills and employability skills are based on the quality of implementation in the learning program. The purpose of this study is to analyze the effect of student active learning on employability skills in life skills education programs. The method used is the correlational quantitative method, the population in this study is all package C students at the Tasikmalaya City SKB. The sampling method uses incidental samples, with a total sample of 35 students. Data collection techniques using questionnaires and observation. The results of the research are based on hypothesis testing obtained from the present collation value of 0.962 which shows a very strong influence with a positive relationship between the learning activeness variable and the employability skill variable. The strong influence of active learning is in the high category with a total percentage of 80% and the level of employability skills is in the high category with a total percentage of 91%. The conclusion from this research is that H1 is fulfilled, namely that there is a significant influence between the active learning of students on employability skills in life skills education programs. Selwin, there is an effect of students' active learning on employability skills, which is equal to 92%, while the rest is the contribution of other variables that are not included in this research model.
