Food Crops is an agricultural sub-sector that plays an important role in meeting food needs for the community. Rice, corn and soybeans are strategic commodities whose role is evidenced by their contribution to GRDP. GRDP is an important indicator to determine the economic condition of a region. This study aims to determine how and how much the influence of Rice, Corn and Soybean Production on GRDP in West Java Province. The research method used is a case study with the analytical tool used in this research is multiple linear regression. This study uses secondary data in the form of time series data from 1992-2021 obtained from the Central Bureau of Statistics 2022. The results showed that simultaneously the production of rice, corn and soybeans affects GRDP in West Java. Partially, rice production has a positive effect and corn has a negative effect on GRDP in West Java, while soybean production has no effect on GRDP in West Java.
