This research aims to determine: (1) The partial influence of the education, health, social protection and Human Development Index (HDI) budgets on Indonesia's economic growth in 2008-2022. (2) The influence of the education, health, social protection and Human Development Index (HDI) budgets together on Indonesia's economic growth in 2008-2022. The research method used is Ordinary Least Square (OLS) with a multiple linear regression analysis model. The data used in the research is time series data covering the years 2008-2022. The research results show that: (1) Partially, the education, health budget and human development index variables have a positive but not significant effect, while the social protection budget variable has a negative and significant effect on economic growth in Indonesia in 2008-2022. (2) Taken together, the education, health, social protection budget and human development index variables have a significant effect on Indonesia in 2008-2022.
