The aim of this research is: (1) to determine the partial influence of per capita income, inflation, and interest rates on household consumption expenditure in Indonesia 2000-2023. (2) to determine the influence of per capita income, inflation, and interest rates together on household consumption expenditure in Indonesia 2000-2023. The data used is secondary data sourced from the Central Statistics Agency (BPS). The method used to analyze data is Ordinary Least Square (OLS) with multiple linear regression and hypothesis testing using partial tests (t tests) and combined tests (F tests). The research results show that: (1) per capita income has a positive and significant effect, while inflation and interest rates have a negative but insignificant effect on household consumption expenditure in Indonesia 2000-2023. (2) together the variables per capita income, inflation, and interest rates have a significant effect on household consumption expenditure in Indonesia 2000-2023.
