ABSTRACT

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FAMILY PLANNING PROGRAM PLANNING IN THE POPULATION CONTROL, FAMILY PLANNING, WOMEN'S EMPOWERMENT AND CHILD PROTECTION OFFICE (DPPKBP3A) OF TASIKMALAYA CITY IN 2024

A significant growth rate will result in a population surge that can trigger various new root problems. The success of the family planning program can be seen from the high CPR rate, which is an indicator of TFR control. DPPKBP3A is the office responsible for population control in the city. Analyzing how the Family Planning Program Planning in DPPKBP3A of Tasikmalaya City in 2024. This research uses a descriptive qualitative design and with purposive sampling interviewed 4 informants, namely the Family Planning, Resilience, and Family Welfare Division of DPPKBP3A Tasikmalaya City (main informant) and the General Planning Division of DPPKBP3A, Coor of PLKB, and its SIGA Admin (triangulation informant). The results showed that the situation analysis was conducted through the SIGA and SIPD applications. Stages of problem identification with risk management analysis and prioritizing problems with the Delbecq method, Determination of objectives and alternative solutions that are in line with the guidelines, namely increasing the percentage of CPR so as to reduce TFR and applicable planning products, namely strategic plans, work plans, and monthly plans. The four stages of family planning program planning in DPPKBP3A Tasikmalaya City are in accordance with the guidelines used, namely BKKBN Regulation No. 55/HK-010/B5/2010 concerning Minimum Service Standards for Family Planning and Family Welfare in Districts / Cities. However, the data and information contained in SIGA are still incomplete due to the absence of 3 out of 5 information needed to make plans.
