Banyak penelitian yang telah membahas tentang pengaturan tempat duduk. Akan tetapi, penelitian-penelitian tersebut masih kurang membahas mengenai pengaturan tempat duduk yang sesuai untuk kelas Bahasa Inggris dari sudut pandang siswa. Maka dari itu, untuk mengembangkan penelitian tersebut, penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengungkap persepsi siswa terhadap penggunaan tempat duduk berjajar (ORSA) yang masih digunakan di sebagian besar ruang kelas dan tempat duduk yang berbentuk huruf U (US) yang sangat direkomendasikan penerapannya untuk berbagai kegiatan di kelas Bahasa Inggris. Penelitian ini melaporkan studi kasus deskriptif dan 6 siswa dari Sekolah Menengah Atas menjadi responden untuk penelitian ini. Adapun metode pengumpulan data yang digunakan yaitu wawancara yang bersifat semi terstruktur dan dianalisis menggunakan analisis tematik (Braun & Clark, 2006). Hasil dari penelitian ini menunjukan bahwa persepsi siswa terhadap penggunaan ORSA dan US di kelas Bahasa Inggris memunculkan isu berupa; (1) US memberikan lebih banyak kenyamanan bagi siswa daripada *ORSA* selama proses pembelajaran, (2) US lebih meningkatkan partisipasi siswa daripada ORSA dalam kegiatan belajar kelas.

#### **ABSTRACT**

**KENTI DEVIANA H. 2019 "Students' Perceptions on Orderly Rows Seating Arrangement (ORSA) and U-Shape (US) in EFL Classroom"** English Education Department. Faculty of Educational Sciences and Teacher's Training (*FKIP*). Siliwangi University. Tasikmalaya.

Several number of studies have been discussed about seating arrangement context. However, those studies still pay less attention to see from the students' perception about proper seating arrangement for EFL classrom. Therefore, to fill this void, this present study intended to investigate the students' perception on the use of ORSA that is still used in the majority of classroom and US which highly recommended for various activities in EFL classroom. This research reports the descriptive case study and 6 students of senior high school is involved to participate in this study. The data collection used is semi-stuctured interview and analysed by using thematic analysis (Braun & Clark, 2006). The result of this study showed that students' perception toward the use of ORSA and US in EFL classroom emerged two issues such as; (1) US Provides more Convenience for the Students than ORSA during the Learning Process, (2) US Boosts Students' Participation more than ORSA in Classroom Activity.
