

Abstract

The research is entitled Relationships between Actors between Actors in Regional Asset Management (case study of Tasikmalaya mayor's official residence). This research is motivated by the alleged power relations that occurred in the Tasikmalaya City government in renting the mayor's official residence . Until now the Tasikmalaya City government does not yet have an official residence for the mayor and deputy mayor. Because there is no official house, the Tasikmalaya City government rents a private house from the mayor to be the mayor's official residence. However, this policy caused a negative stigma among the people because the government did not transparency regarding the rental costs incurred and which policies or regulations were used in renting the private house. In making policies, of course there are actors involved, who are the actors involved in making policy regarding the assets of this official residence?

Theories used to examine this problem are the Power of Relation Theory , Political Actors and Asset Management Theory. The research method used is qualitative research methods with a case study approach . The technique of determining informants is done by purposive sampling and snowball sampling. Data collection is done by interview and documentation.

The results showed that renting private houses used as official housing is indeed permitted if the regional government does not yet have the assets of the area. The power relations between actors involved in regional asset management (official residence of the mayor) in making policies must have involved actors, namely the mayor as the highest authority and authority in the region, members of the special committee formed by the DPRD who are representatives of each faction, and the regional secretariat the development section which deals with the development of regional assets in the city of Tasikmalaya.
