ABSTRACT

ANALYSIS OF THE WELFARE LEVEL OF TEA PICKING WORKERS

This study aims to analyze the contribution of tea picking workers' income to the total household income of tea picking workers and to analyze the level of welfare based on the income and expenses of tea picking farm workers. The research method used is a survey method to analyze the welfare level of tea picking workers located in Sukaluyu Village, Pangalengan District, Bandung Regency. The data was obtained by means of direct observation and interviews with respondents. The results of sampling from 8 farmer groups using Proportional Random Sampling obtained a sample of 72 respondents. The results showed that the the contribution of total agricultural income almost touched the figure of 53.15 percent consisting of income from picking laborers by 44.23 percent and income from garden workers by 8.92 percent, it can be concluded that the fulfillment of household income from agriculture can fulfill the integrity of the farmer's household. Households of tea picking workers in Sukalyu village are considered as prosperous families because the NTPRTP value is > 1, which is 2.06.
