International trade is very important for every country in helping economic growth. Export activities are part of international trade where a country can produce goods and services that can be sold abroad. As an equatorial country endowed with diverse natural resources, Indonesia can export products from natural resources. Clove (Syzygium aromaticum, syn, euginia aromaticum) is a native plant of Indonesia from the Myrtaceage tree family, its use is from fragrant flower stalks and buds. Indonesia's clove commodity is in great demand by the world so that it can generate foreign exchange and can become the largest clove supplier in the world. This study aims to identify the factors that influence and examine how much influence the amount of production, export prices and the Rupiah exchange rate have on Indonesian clove exports in the period from 2005 to 2019. The data were analyzed descriptively with a quantitative approach and using multiple linear regression equations. The results of the analysis test using Eviews 10 obtained the results of the amount of clove production, clove export prices and the Rupiah exchange rate having a significant simultaneous effect on Indonesia's clove exports. Partially, the amount of clove production had an insignificant negative effect on Indonesia's clove exports, the price of clove exports had a significant positive effect on Indonesia's clove exports, and the Rupiah exchange rate had an insignificant positive effect on Indonesia's clove exports.
