ABSTARCT

THE EFFECT OF INDUSTRIAL AGLOMERATION, LABOR FORCE PARTICIPATION RATE, WAGE LEVEL ON THE REGIONAL AND HUMAN DEVELOPMENT INDEX ON ECONOMIC GROWTH IN WEST JAVA IN 2005-2020 PERIOD

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This study aims to determine the effect of Industrial Agglomeration, Labor Force Participation Rate, Wage Level on Regional and Human Development Index on Economic Growth in West Java for the 2005-2020 Period, either partially or jointly. The research method used in this study is a quantitative method with the type of data used in the form of secondary data obtained from the website of the Central Statistics Agency (BPS), said data and open data Jabar. The data analysis technique used in this research is multiple linear regression. The results showed that partially industrial agglomeration and labor force participation rate had a positive and insignificant effect, while the wage rate had a significant positive effect and the Human Development Index had a negative and significant effect on growth West Java. Meanwhile, collectively, Industrial economic inAgglomeration, Labor Force Participation Rate, Wage Level and Human Development Index have a significant effect on West Java's Economic Growth for the 2005-2020 period.
