ABSTRACT

The problem in this study is the low learning achievement of students. While the purpose of this study was to determine how much influence the facilities and infrastructure, learning independence and student interest in learning achievement partially and simultaneously. The research approach used in this research is quantitative research. Data collection techniques using a questionnaire (questionnaire), interviews and observations. The population was taken as many as 230 with a sample of 230 students at MA Cilendek Kota Tasikmalaya in the academic year 2020/2021. The technique used in determining the sample is saturated sample with a significant level of 5%. The results of multiple linear regression test obtained equations Y = 22.057 + 0.007 X I + $0.140 \times 2 + 0.290 \times 3$. The linear regression equation can be interpreted that the facilities and infrastructure, learning independence and student interest have a positive impact on student achievement in MA Cilendek Kota Tasikmalaya simultaneously, namely F_hitung 23.069 and F table 2.644 with a significance value of 0.000 this is in accordance with the test criteria showing F hitung > F table with a significance level of 0.000 < 0.05 from the alpha level of 5% or 0.05with an R square of 23,4% so that it can be concluded that the influence of facilities and infrastructure, independent learning and student interest on learning achievement is 23.4% while the rest 76.6% is influenced by other factors.
