## **RENTABILITY OF GOAT FATTENING BUSINESSES**

This study aims to find out the costs and business income on the level of profitability or percentage received by etawa breeders. The research method used a case study on Etawa breeders, in Salamnunggal, Sirnagalih, Indihiang, Tasikmalaya. Determination of respondents using direct interviews with etawa breeders. The data collected from interviews are collected in the form of tables and then the results are calculated in the form of percentages during one production period. The results of the study showed that the implementation of etawa breeding fattening was carried out in an intensive method by properly and correctly managed maintenance. The amount of capital spent on the PE goat fattening effort with a total of 25 tails for 4 months is equal to, Rp. 62.776.499 with a profit of Rp. 12.223.501. Businesses with fattening patterns in breeders are feasible to run because of the resulting profitability value of 19.47 percent, with current bank interest of 14 percent per year. So when compared to the rentability value greater than bank interest, it can be concluded that the rentability of fattening goats of etawa breeds is included in the category feasible to be cultivated and developed.
